#### NEW WEBSITE

Please remember that if you are planning to make any exterior changes to your home or landscaping, all projects must be approved by the ARC Architectural Review Committee. This includes ALL exterior projects such as fences, decks, patios, large tree removal, exterior painting, landscaping and much more. ## WALKERS ON GOLF COURSE

Please remember that the golf course and cart paths are for golf use only. To protect the safety of residents and golfers, please do not walk, ride bikes or allow pets on the golf course or cart paths at any time.

#### LEAF COLLECTION

The City of Hoover will once again provide leaf collection this year. The city offers the following suggestions for safe and effective leaf collections:

- Please rake leaves to the curb one day prior to your collection days.
- Do not place twigs, branches, rocks, bricks, bags or other items in your leaves that could create an obstruction in the vacuum hose of the leaf collection truck.
- Do not place leaves near storm drains, fire hydrants, mailboxes, utility wires and other obstacles.
- Do not place leaves close to vehicles.
- Place leaves in the yard within 4 feet of the curb or asphalt. The leaf collection truck's vacuum cannot reach leaves that are further away than 4 feet from the truck.

The collection schedule for Riverchase (Zone 5) can be found on the Hoover website, www.hooveralabama.gov under the Garbage & Recycling tab. We will also have the schedule on the RRA website once it has been published.

Bagged leaves will continue to be collected at the curb on your regular garbage and trash days. If you have more than 20 bags of leaves for pick-up, please submit a request to the Hoover Public Works department to have them collected via the Let Us Help link at hooveralabama.gov or call 444-7543 or 631-1313.

#### LET'S LIGHT UP RIVERCHASE THIS YEAR!!

Call Mal at 612-4939 if you would like a tree frame made and delivered to your home for \$30 each. You purchase the lights of your choosing and string them. Most homes display 3-4 trees.

If you would like to make the trees yourself, the details are below.

Lighted 2 – 6' 2X2 Boards 1 – 4' 2X2 Board

Christmas 17 Galvanized Nails 1 - 300-400 Strand of Lights

Tree 1 – Large Bike Hook

Take the two 6' boards and connect them at one end to make a triangle point. Next, attach the 4' board to the bottom on the 6' boards so you make a triangle. Attach your large bike hook to the top point of the triangle. Evenly space 17 nails along the 4' board (on the same side as the bike hook). Then start at the bottom and string the strand of lights up and down the tree around every nail. When finished, attach the lighted tree to a tree in your yard.

#### CHRISTMAS DECORATIONS

The Christmas holidays are rapidly approaching! Each year the Riverchase Residential Association Board provides for Christmas decorations for all entrances and street signs.

Here are a few suggestions for your holiday decorations:

- Red velvet bows on the mailbox give the most impact. Bows or wire-edged red velvet ribbon may be purchased at many local home accessories stores.
- Adding greenery and other holiday items with the bow on the mailbox looks even more festive.
- The triangular lighted trees seen around Riverchase are easy and inexpensive to make. The instructions for making a tree of your own can be found above.

Please remember that Christmas decorations need to be removed two weeks after Christmas. Thanks so much for your cooperation.
